

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid - FAFSA



Completion of the FAFSA guarantees evaluation for all types of federal and State aid.

Provisional Student Aid Guidelines

- In order to be eligible for federal and State **financial aid** you must be a **matriculated** student in an approved TCNJ degree program.
- Once you are admitted for the Spring semester the Financial Aid Office will evaluate your FAFSA data and package you for eligible aid.
- There are two lenders Sallie Mae and Wells Fargo that offer loans to non-matriculated students. For more information visit our web site at: http://financialaid.tcnj.edu/

Student Aid Report (SAR)

Serves as confirmation that the FAFSA was received by the Federal processor.

Sent to the student's e-mail address provided on the FAFSA.

A student can add schools on FAFSA.gov or over the phone by calling 1-800-4-FED-AID. TCNJ's school code is 002642.


E-mail is our official means of communication

Private Scholarships

You are required to report all private scholarships that you will receive for the 2017-2018 school year.

Priority Deadline: Report as soon as possible Online Form Available after May 1st, 2017

- TCNJ will give you <u>a temporary credit</u> on your TCNJ bill until the scholarship funds arrive.
- Once reported allow 5 to 7 business days for scholarship to appear on your PAWS account
- Actual scholarship funds must be received one month after classes start!

Budgeting for "The Gap"?

- The GAP is the difference between your TCNJ bill (direct costs) and your estimated financial aid.
- Example: (in-state, on-campus student, current year)

The Gap is the additional funding you will need to pay the bill

TCNJ Authorized Users (Auxiliary Access)

An Authorized User is an individual who has been granted permission to view and discuss a student's billing, financial aid, and/or education records. TCNJ students are eligible to grant this access to up to three individuals with whom they wish to share their account details. Once enrolled as Authorized Users, these individuals are granted auxiliary access to the College's information system (PAWS), where they can log in to complete the following tasks:

- · View financial aid
- · View the student To-Do list
- View and pay the bill
- · View education records
