Once logged in, you can click on the Financial Aid tile; this will display your award(s). You do not need to accept/decline awards at this time. This is for budgeting purposes only. Additionally, TCNJ has made the College Financing Plan available to all students. This standardized form is designed to simplify the information that students receive about the costs to attend TCNJ. You can access the College Financing Plan link on the left side of the screen when you are viewing your financial aid on the Award Summary page.

Merit scholarships are awarded by our Admissions Office. Students that are eligible for a merit scholarship were notified of such in their initial acceptance letter.
